If Life Originated By Chance, So Could God

What is the origin of life on Earth?

The most intelligent scientists admit they do not really know for sure.

George Wald suffered from what we call "Atheism Blindness" which is a mental deficiency. That is why he never thought of the fact that if Man could come about by chance, so could God.
